**ORDER FOR AN INJUNCTION AFTER THE ISSUE  
OF A WRIT OF SUMMONS**

**IMPORTANT:**

**NOTICE TO THE DEFENDANT**

1. This Order prohibits you from doing the acts set out in this Order. You should read it all carefully. You are advised to consult a Solicitor as soon as possible. You have a right to ask the Court to vary or discharge this Order.

2. If you disobey this Order you may be found guilty of Contempt of Court and may be sent to prison or fined or your assets may be seized.

An Application was made on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of July 2014 by Counsel for the Plaintiff to the Judge. The Judge heard the application and read the evidence listed in Schedule 1 and accepted the undertakings in Schedule 2 at the end of this Order.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

**THE INJUNCTION**

(1) Until after the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July 2014 or further Order in the meantime the Defendant must not, without further order of the court, whether by themselves, their servants or agents or otherwise howsoever: -

- i. Enter onto, occupy or be on the lands situate at and known as Gandrum Road, County Fermanagh, contained in Folios FE 2732, FE 1950 and FE 1675 Co. Fermanagh and more particularly delineated in red in the map annexed hereto ('the Lands'), which said Lands are occupied by the plaintiff under Lease;

- ii. Interfere with and/or prevent the Plaintiffs, its servants or agents, from carrying on exploratory mining operations at or about the Lands under Petroleum Licence granted by the Department of Enterprise Trade and Investment to Tamboran on 1 April 2011;
- iii. Obstruct access to and/or egress from the Lands

(2) There shall be a further hearing of this Order on the Return Date.

### **COSTS OF THE APPLICATION**

(2) The costs of this Application are reserved.

### **PARTIES OTHER THAN THE INTENDED PLAINTIFF AND INTENDED RESPONDENT**

It is a Contempt of Court for any person notified of this Order to knowingly assist in or permit a breach of this Order. Any person doing so may be sent to prison, fined or have his assets seized.

### **VARIATION OR DISCHARGE OF THIS ORDER**

The Defendant (or anyone notified of this Order) may apply to the Court at any time to vary or discharge this Order, but if he wishes to do so, he must first inform the Plaintiff's Solicitors in writing at least 48 hours beforehand.

### **INTERPRETATION OF THIS ORDER**

1. In this Order the words "he" "him" or "his" include "she" or "her" and "it" or "its".
2. Where there are two or more Defendants then (unless the contrary appears)
  - (a) References to "the Defendant" mean both or all of them;
  - (b) An Order requiring "the Defendant" to do or not to do anything requires each Defendant to do or not to do it.

### **THE EFFECT OF THIS ORDER**

1. A Defendant who is an individual and who is ordered not to do something, must not do it himself or in any other way. He must not do it through others acting on his behalf or on his instructions or with his encouragement.
2. A Defendant which is a corporation and which is ordered not to do something, must not do it itself or by its directors, officers, employees or agents or in any other way.

**SCHEDULE 2****Undertakings given to the Court by the Plaintiff**

1. The plaintiff shall serve copies of this Order, together with the ex-parte docket and affidavit of Karl Prenderville dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July 2014 together with the exhibits thereto upon the defendants by means of: -
  - i. Affixing it to conspicuous places on the perimeter fence at the lands so that they are clearly visible;
  - ii. Making copies of this order available at the Lands, said copies to be given to any person who requests a copy as soon as is reasonably practicable;
  - iii. Notifying the local media of the existence of this order as soon as is reasonably practicable.
2. If the Court later finds that this Order has caused loss to the Defendant and decides that the Defendant should be compensated for that loss, the Plaintiff will comply with any Order the Court may make.
